## Legacy PCL API

Although the legacy PACER Case Locator (PCL) will be decommissioned in the future, PACER users can still use it at <https://pcl-legacy.uscourts.gov>. The following document discusses the legacy PCL API, which is being replaced by the new authentication and query API for PCL. For more details on the new PCL API, contact [developers@psc.uscourts.gov](mailto:developers@psc.uscourts.gov) and request to be included on the list of developers who receive new information as it becomes available.

## Legacy PCL API Usage

In addition to the standard user interface provided by the legacy PCL, you can write your own queries with the API. The API also provides most of the same search capabilities as the user interface, and it can easily be used by automated scripts. Basically, the user sends an HTTP GET or POST to the exposed query method to start a query. After a successful query submission, the query service returns a URL where the results will reside.

This document is for users who want to write automated scripts for data retrieval using the legacy PCL query API. It also is a complete reference document for all the data elements used in the PCL query API.

The basic steps outlined in this document include the following:

1. Legacy PACER authentication: POST your login credentials and get a PacerSession authentication cookie.
2. Start legacy PCL query: POST your query parameters and get a link to download the results.
3. Retrieve results from legacy PCL query: GET your query results.

---

**NOTE:** There is no pagination provided for retrieving results, so be aware that **the system bills for the entire results set upon downloading the query from the API.**

---

To access any legacy PCL API services, a valid PacerSession cookie and referrer header are required in the header of each HTTP request. For details and examples, see the detailed service definition in this document.



## Part II - Legacy PCL Queries

The following describes how to use the PCL to automatically download XML results. This is not a conventional API, as it was not designed for automated usage. Instead, this document describes how one can use the URLs used by the UI to automatically generate the results in XML format. There are two steps: first, the query starts; and second, the results of the query are retrieved.

---

**NOTE:** You must access Legacy PACER Authentication to get the PacerSession authentication token that is required in all queries to the API.

---

### Step 1

#### **Start a PCL Query**

Endpoint: <https://pcl-legacy.uscourts.gov/dquery>  
Request-method: GET or POST  
Content-type: application/x-www-form-urlencoded  
Parameters: As described in the attached Appendix A  
PacerSession cookie: Required cookie set by the authentication service needs to be in all requests  
Referer header: Required referrer header set to <https://pcl-legacy.uscourts.gov/search>

The referer header must be set in each request, or you will be redirected (HTTP 302) to the search screen. To use POST instead of a GET, just include the Content-type header and put the query parameters in the body of the request instead of of the URL.

### Step 2

#### **Get the results of the query. Use the “Location” header from the HTTP 302 response in Step 1 to get the results of your query.**

Endpoint: <https://pcl-legacy.uscourts.gov/download>  
Request-method: GET  
Parameters: rid (report ID returned from Step 1)  
PacerSession cookie: Required cookie set by the authentication service needs to be in all requests  
Referer header: Required referrer header set to <https://pcl-legacy.uscourts.gov/search>

When you successfully start the query in step 1, the PCL will return an HTTP 302 redirect to the URL where your query results reside. The report ID (rid) should be included in the query parameters of the GET request when picking up the results.
